A School Opportunity: A Visiting Author

Intention:

Drawing upon years of leading classroom discussions with children about their emotions and feelings, Linda is now assisting children in becoming increasingly aware and sensitive to animals and their feelings, on supporting the creative writing and illustrating process in the classroom, and teaching about the writing and publishing process.

Classroom Presentations: Developed in concert with the classroom teacher's objectives.

Creative writing

- Share and discuss Regal's story. Explore Regal's feelings and have children identify the feelings of the animals they have known in their lives.
- Have children write their animal stories and illustrate. Create a classroom book.
- Teach about the book, the writing process, and the benefits gained from this extraordinary experience - supported with examples of work, slides, and video.
- Speak to issues regarding the care of animals and the significant benefits of our animal relationships.

Talk about the writing and publishing process

- Speak to and answer questions about writing, book editing and design, and the realities of the publishing world.
- Share about Independent Publishing and book marketing (platform, team building, Internet).

Guidelines:

- Presentations, with interaction time, adjusted to grade level: 30 – 60 minutes; group size – up to two classrooms for older students and class size for 3rd grade or below.
- Goals mutually developed with staff so that teacher objectives are fulfilled.
- Presentation fees: Half day \$600/full day \$1200 (negotiable/time factor).
- Book clubs (adult or student) – Linda is available for book signing and short Q & A in person.
